 - Cookies and tracking technologies
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4. Purpose of Data Collection

We process personal data for the following purposes:

- Connecting prospective students with suitable educational programs
 - Supporting universities in managing international admissions pipelines
 - Facilitating partnerships between institutions and Global Amoss
 - Communicating relevant opportunities, services, and updates
 - Improving website performance and user experience
 - Marketing activities (only with consent where required)
 - Compliance with legal and regulatory obligations
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5. Legal Basis for Processing

We process data under the following legal bases:

- **Consent:** when users voluntarily submit their information
 - **Contractual necessity:** to deliver our services to clients and partners
 - **Legitimate interests:** to improve services, grow partnerships, and operate efficiently
 - **Legal obligations:** where required by law
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6. Data Sharing and Third Parties

We may share data with trusted third-party providers, including:

- CRM and marketing platforms
- Website hosting and analytics providers
- Communication tools (email, automation platforms)
- Partner universities (only when relevant to student placement or inquiries)

All third parties are required to process data securely and in compliance with GDPR.

We do **not** sell personal data.

7. Data Security

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8. Data Retention

- Student and lead data: up to 24 months from last interaction
- Client and partner data: up to 5 years after relationship ends
- Legal/financial data: retained as required by law

Data may be deleted earlier upon request where legally permitted.

As an international business, some data may be processed outside the European Economic Area (EEA).

When this happens, we ensure appropriate safeguards are in place, such as Standard Contractual Clauses approved by the European Commission.
